

# Summer Student Position

Programs, worship services and events are inclusive to people of every nationality, ability level, sexual orientation and gender identity. We aim to create space for youth of different nationalities (indigenous, new Canadians etc.) and persons with disabilities to belong and connect. We are looking for someone who desires to grow in their own Christian faith as they collaborate, learn and lead in a church context.

### Who Can Apply:

- A student enrolled in full time studies.
- Between the ages of 15 and 30
- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada with a valid Social Insurance Number
